

## Reading Projects



-  **Create a mosaic or collage of quotes, thoughts, ideas and pictures related to this book. Must be on 8x11 board and covered.**
-  **Create a timeline of 15 events for the book, including an illustration and a caption for each event. Get creative with materials used!**
-  **Design a Facebook profile for a character in your book. Decide with whom your character would be friends with, and what he or she would list as interests, favorite quotations and website “likes”. Place on a 8x11 board, and get creative with materials used!**
-  **Design the front of a newspaper. Write a news story (3 paragraphs) explaining the implications of a major event in your book.**
-  **Find the top 10 appropriate web sites a character in your book would most frequently visit. Include 2-3 sentences for each site, and why your character likes them. Use whatever medium displaying your web site.**
-  **Write a caption summary(2-3 sentences) for each chapter and illustrate the caption. Get creative with materials used!**
-  **Select one character from the book you read who has the qualities of a heroine or hero. List at least 6 of these qualities in a caption (2-3 sentences), telling why/how your character displayed these, and illustrate their heroism.**
-  **Write the story from a different point of view. Take the entire story (or part of it) and write a version as someone else would tell it. At least 300 words.**
-  **Write a 3 paragraph proposal to have the book you’ve read made into a movie. Include which actors will play the main characters in the movie and why, and the location where the movie will be filmed, and why. Create a movie poster for the book. It should include elements from a real movie poster such as slogan, the actors and the rating.**
-  **Write a diary that one of the story’s main characters might have kept before, during, or after the book’s events. Remember that the character’s thoughts and feelings are very important in a diary. The diary should contain at least 15 thorough entries.**
-  **Stories are based on conflicts and solutions. Choose three conflicts (problems) that take place in the story and give the solutions. Pick one that you wish had been handled differently and explain how it should have been handled. Write at least 300 words.**
